

To whom it may concern

This is to confirm that as to June 2020 all products from NORD-LOCK AB are manufactured in accordance with the following directives:

- European Directive 2000/53/EC on End of Life Vehicles (ELV) July 1st 2005
- EU Directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) of June 8th 2011.
- EU Directive 2015/863:

The RoHS Directive restricts the use of Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent chromium (Cr⁶⁺), Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE), Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP), Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP) in manufacturing of certain electrical and electronic equipment sold in the European Union.

None of these substances are deliberately included in our products. Occasionally traces of the elements could be found due to the raw materials used. However the maximum concentration levels set by the directives are never exceeded.
